We challenge you to read, reread, and pray over this passage before continuing.....

Psalm 91:1 He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High  
will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. 2 I will say of the LORD,  
"He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."

Verse 1 talks about the "shadow of the Almighty" You are going to have a sense of security walking in the protective shadow of someone bigger than you. Someone who cares for you. Satan is not going to like it when you walk closely to God, in the shadow of His presence. He will constantly be trying to get you out of God's shadow, His presence, being near Him.

Verse 2 talks about God being our refuge. A refuge is a condition of being safe or sheltered from pursuit, danger, or trouble. The shadow of God is our refuge, our safe place that we can take shelter. Because God is our fortress, we need to put our hope and trust in Him and not in the world.

Are you close enough to God that you are resting in His shadow? Our prayer is that you will come to a place where you recognize Him as your refuge and put your hope and trust in Him through any situation or season of life you may be going through.
